

# OWN A PIECE OF HISTORY



The Chambers of Commerce around the Lake of the Ozarks and the Adopt-the-Shoreline Program have teamed up to offer a once in a lifetime opportunity to bid on a custom made table from wood salvaged from the Lake of the Ozarks. The western cedar logs used in the construction of this table were part of the log boom originally installed to prevent debris from entering Bagnell Dam.

After being submerged in the Lake of the Ozarks for more than 75 years, Rick Braun at the Wood Merchant in Lampe, Missouri has used these massive logs to create a truly unique custom dining table. The table measures 84" long x 48" wide x 30" high and incorporates some of the original fasteners and cable pieces removed from the logs as part of the tabletop design.

The table can be viewed at Willmore Lodge located at 1 Willmore Lane in Lake Ozark.
