- CDC along with State and Local health departments announce order for public facilities or event be limited to 10 or less patrons for 15 days. - Missouri Small Businesses Affected by Coronavirus (COVID 19) can Apply for SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan - Businesses can now apply for SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans are working capital loans to help small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private, non-profit organizations of all sizes meet their ordinary and necessary financial obligations that cannot be met as a direct result of the disaster. These loans are intended to assist through the disaster recovery period. If you do have a traditional lender, please contact them to discuss your concerns.
